Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Do you ever find yourself singing the words or humming the melody of a hymn? This very thing occurs on a regular basis for me. I don't always know why a phrase or tune comes to mind, but I welcome them anyway. Several times a year, the first stanza of "For All the Saints" pops in my head and before I know it I am singing "For all the saints who from their labors rest, who thee by faith before the world confessed..." This is one of my favorite hymns. Full of rich imagery, it helps us understand what we mean when we say each week in the Apostles' Creed, "I believe in communion of saints."

The communion of saints are *ALL* of God's children—those who have died, those who are living, and those who are yet to be. God, who transcends time and place, gathers all of God's children into one beautiful union as this stanza from "For All the Saints" describes. "Oh, blest communion fellowship divine, we feebly struggle, they in glory shine; yet all are one in thee for all are thine. Alleluia! Alleluia!" In the mystery of God's grace we are forever united in love to God and to all of our brothers and sisters in all times and in all places.

All Saints Sunday is November 7 this year and on that day, we will give God thanks for those in our congregational family (members, family, and friends) who have died in the past two years. We will read aloud their names and light candles as we remember them. These beloved children of God have joined the Church Triumphant. In the sure and certain hope of the resurrection we will join them someday. Until then, we remain united with all of God's people in the communion of saints.

Whether or not the lyrics and tune of "For All the Saints" pops into your head from time to time throughout the coming year, may we always hold in our hearts and minds the union we share with all of God's people.
