

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

I learned a few years ago that one of my favorite Christmas hymns, "Joy to the World," is actually an Advent hymn. As I've been thinking about what I want my Advent to look like this year, the phrase from verse one, "Let every heart prepare him room," has come to mind multiple times.

I love Christmas and everything about it...the music, the decorating, baking, time with family and friends, and the list goes on. Sometimes I get so excited for Christmas and I get caught up in preparing for Christmas, that I let Advent fall by the wayside. And if I am being completely honest, I really don't like waiting. I tend to think of waiting as a waste of time. However, when we wait upon God, nothing is wasted—not even time.

So, I want my Advent this year to be a season of preparing room in my heart for Christ as I wait for Christmas to come. I think of the preparations I make when I have guests coming—I clean, I get my guest room ready, I plan meals and stock my fridge. Or think about parents who are awaiting the birth of a child...they nest and prepare their home and the baby's room for the babe's arrival.

I want to spend Advent nesting in my heart, preparing room in my heart for Jesus. This might look like removing some clutter in my heart—things that are taking up space that I want Jesus to occupy. It might mean sweeping away some of the dust and debris that gathers. It might mean letting go of some things I have been holding on to that no longer serve me.

As you think about how you can prepare room in your heart for Jesus this Advent, we have several resources available in the Narthex. Additionally, come to the Wednesday evening worship services to pray and hear God's word.

The temptation is strong to skip over Advent and jump right into Christmas, but God invites us to slow down and wait. And as we wait, "Let every heart prepare him room."
