Dear Sisters and Brothers,

As the end of 2021 approaches, I have set aside time to reflect on the past year and to think about the coming year. And as I have let my mind meander its way through memories of what has been and hopes for what is to come...the lyrics from John Lennon's "Happy Christmas, the War is Over" keep running through my head. The song opens with these words: "So this is Christmas, and what have you done? Another year over, a new one just begun."

We are getting ready to enter the season of Christmas. Christmas does not end on the 25th, it starts that day. In the church calendar, Christmas is not a one day event. Christmas begins on December 25 and lasts for twelve days. These twelve days make up the season called Christmastide.

"So this is Christmas...another year over...a new one just begun." I think it is significant that as we enter the new year, we are simultaneously in the midst of Christmastide. January 1 is the eighth day of Christmas. As the new year begins, we are still celebrating the inbreaking of God into the world that God so loves as a newborn baby.

Christmastide concludes with the Feast of Epiphany on January 6 when we joyfully celebrate God's revealing Christ and the light of Christ to the nations and to all people.

Join us for worship on the second day of Christmas, December 26, for Lessons and Carols and then again on January 9, as we celebrate the Feast of Epiphany.
