

For example, this spring, he held a Teach-In Forum that was attended by several dozen students, faculty and community members, to get a perspective on the situation in Ukraine.

Norris is also the Associate Director for the College Honors Program and the Jefferson-Pilot Endowed Professor. The Jefferson-Pilot Professorship is awarded every two years to a faculty member who makes an outstanding contribution to the college.

Committee Reports

Robert gave a report from the O'Dell Black Committee as follows:

The O'Dell Black Committee has given a 10% tithe (\$15,600) of the gift (\$155,895.01) to the following organizations – The Pastor's Pantry (\$3,000), The Back-Pack Program (\$4,000), The Life Center (\$2,000), Meals on Wheels (\$3,000), Crisis Ministry (\$2,000), Salvation Army (\$1,000) and Women's Domestic Violence Shelter (\$600). The Committee had 4 trees on the church property cut down for a total of \$3,800.

Old Business

Norris made the motion, Herbert seconded and motion approved that we accept the February 7 Option 1 quote in the amount of \$11,330 from Davidson Heat and Air to replace the heat/air unit in the back part of the church. The quote was only good for 14 days so Norris also included in his motion that this be approved to include a possible increase of up to \$500 above the original quote and money for this replacement to come from the Building Fund.

New Business

Pastor Anna reported that the Carillons can't be repaired and received several quotes to replace. Replacement will cost around \$8,000. Norris made the motion, Chip seconded and motion passed that new Carillons be replaced in memory of Etta Lee Conrad using Memorial monies given for Etta Lee, Carl and Lauren. Any cost above memorial monies available will be paid by the family. The family will make the presentation on Mother's Day.

Reviewed the Recreation Committee guidelines. The council will send to the committee a recommendation that the guidelines be rewritten to read that there be no practice at the ballfield during any worship services and during Vacation Bible School.

There being no further business Norris made the motion to adjourn and Kim seconded. The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
